

# Waste Disposal

## • Non-hazardous Waste

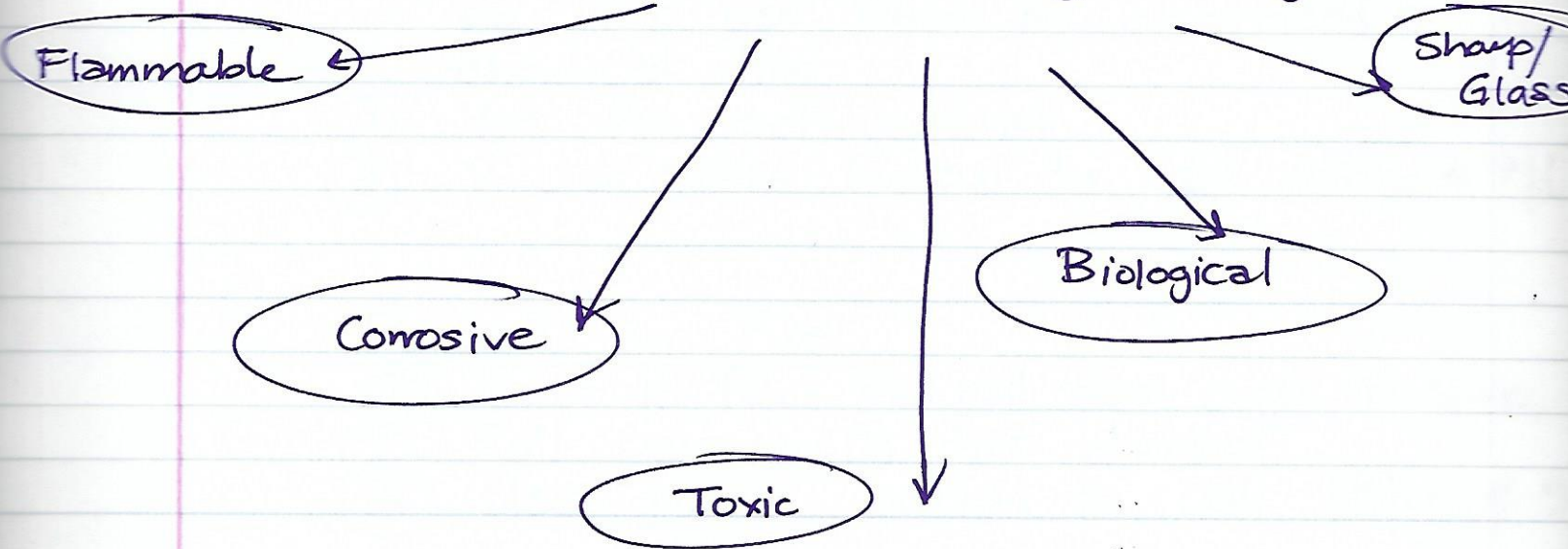
- do NOT threaten living things directly but may cause other problems.

- paper
- paper towels
- sand
- clay
- soil (etc.)

Radioactive

## • Hazardous waste

- never dispose of in a way that can threaten living things



- disposed of in approved container  
\* never down sink unless told to do so.

\* Dispose of chemical waste in chemical waste container

## Washing Your Hands

- always wash your hands thoroughly @ end of lab session.
- keep hands away from mouth, eyes, nose and face in general
- wash your hands AFTER you have cleaned up lab station

## Managing Accidents

### Fire @ Work Station

- ① Tell adult in charge & get away  
Do NOT use water on electrical or chemical fire
- ② Use fire extinguisher
- ③ Use panic button to call office & 911

### Person on Fire

- ① Drop to floor and roll from side to side
- ② Roll person in fire blanket
- ③ Use panic button to call office & 911

### Fire Extinguisher

Aim  
Squeeze

## Handling Sharp Instruments

- When using a razor blade or scalpel you should cut the material AWAY from you.
